Telford College

Telford College's mission is to be an outstanding educational provider for our community.

With campuses in Wellington and Telford town centre, we are Telford & Wrekin's further education college. Recognised as a major training hub for employers across the region, we deliver A levels, T-Levels, apprenticeships, vocational and higher education courses, supporting over 2,000 young people in college-based programmes, 700 apprentices, and more than 3,000 adult learners each academic year.

The college offers apprenticeships across key industries such as accounting, automotive, business, computing, construction, early years, education, engineering, and health, with opportunities ranging from level 2 to level 5. These apprenticeships provide valuable qualifications, real-world work experience, and a chance to earn while learning.

In addition, Telford College offers short, flexible upskilling programmes, available both in-person and online. These include courses in team leading, business administration, dementia care, safeguarding, and mental health first aid. Learn a new skill or upskill staff, gaining qualifications in trades such as automotive, construction, engineering, digital or health and social care.

The college also provides a variety of courses aimed at boosting employability skills, including English and maths, access to higher education, HGV class 2 & Forklift Truck licences, and CSCS cards, ideal for jobseekers or those looking to progress in their current careers.


Apprenticeships

Management and leadership

Management and leadership is one of the most requested training requirements from our businesses. Apprenticeships from Team Leader level through to Senior Manager are available through our network of Training Providers. Depending on the level and the provider, tailored options are available.

Introduction to providers

With over 800 apprenticeship standards covering all industry sectors, navigating the complex landscape can be off putting. We make introductions to local Training Providers, if the business needs can't be met locally we will source a national provider for you.



We find it difficult to know what training is out there for employers to take advantage of. It can be difficult to fully understand what courses are available in the area.

Funding

The Apprenticeship Levy is one of the sources of funding to cover the cost of apprenticeship training but for non-levy paying businesses, the government will support with funding. Many businesses lack knowledge around the levy and apprenticeship funding. We can support you to understand the complexities and also provide advice on the funding process.

Other training

Introduction to providers

Where government funding isn't an option, we can offer bespoke training on a commercial basis.

Lifetime skills guarantee

Subject to eligibility, free level 3 qualifications are accessible for those employed or unemployed and offered locally. We can support with advice and introductions to local Training Providers.

Bootcamps

Bootcamps offer free, flexible training linked to local labour market opportunities, ending with an interview on completion of the training. Developed with industry and employers, these can be an effective source of recruitment. We can advise on availability of relevant Bootcamps and introduce you to local providers delivering within your sector.

Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQ's)

Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQ's) are fully funded level 4 programmes, aligned to specific sectors and can be used either as a standalone module to up-skill or as a route into to further higher-level learning.

T Levels

T Levels combine classroom and industry learning and include a 45-day industry placement either day release or on block. Fully funded by government they can be an excellent way to build a talent pipeline.

Recruitment & Retention

Advice

We provide advice on job descriptions, the local labour pool and sector focused pre-employment programmes that provide a pipeline of potential employees. We also understand the current initiatives and support available locally. The team also has information on local infrastructure and services for new businesses in the borough or for those recruiting from out of the borough.

Job advertising

We can help with free advertising of job opportunities through Telford Jobbox, DWP, graduate websites, links into students, community teams and other organisations providing jobsearch support.

Specialist advisory services

We can offer specialist services to businesses and employees. This includes advice on health conditions, disabilities and workforce adaptations to aid recruitment and retention as well as job coaching an in-work support for new recruits in the early days of employment.

Introduction to companies making redundancies

We can make direct HR to HR introductions between businesses that are making redundancies with those recruiting where skill sets are similar. We can also advise on any funded training to aid the transition.

Employment fairs

We support employment fairs across the borough which can offer the opportunity for face to face engagement, including interviews on the day. For larger recruitment within a business, we can support with a company specific recruitment fair either on the business premises, community venue or one of our premises.

HR Forum

The HR forum is a network of businesses sharing best practice and information. Regular communications and face to face meetings covering topical issues and employment law updates provide an opportunity to understand the skills and recruitment landscape within Telford and Wrekin.
